- Provide pastoral care and develop disciple-making pathways and church membership culture.
- Serve within an elder-led model; accountable to the Elders (who are the Trustees).

You will:

- Be a mature, godly Christian man, meeting the biblical criteria for eldership and demonstrating servant-hearted leadership.
- Have theological clarity and convictions aligned with the position statements of the church and AMiE.
- Have a heart for reaching rural and small-town communities across North Essex.
- Be able to build from the ground up and excited by early-stage church planting work.
- Have theological training from a reputable institution.
